Meyer S. Balter, MD, is Director of the Asthma and COPD Education Clinic at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto, Canada, and a Professor of Medicine at the University of Toronto. After receiving his medical degree from McGill University, Dr Balter completed an internship and residency in internal medicine and was Chief Medical Resident at Montreal General Hospital. This was followed by clinical and research fellowships in pulmonary and critical care medicine at the University of Michigan Hospital. Dr Balter is currently a staff member in the Division of Respiratory Medicine at Mount Sinai Hospital and University Health Network

The Mount Sinai Hospital Department of Medicine has honored Dr Balter with seven Outstanding Teaching Awards. His major clinical interest aside from asthma and COPD is sarcoidosis. He has been named a Distinguished Chest Educator by the ACCP for the second year in a row.

Dr Balter's professional affiliations and activities include the Ontario and Canadian Medical Associations, American College of Chest Physicians, and the American, European, and Canadian Thoracic Societies. He serves as a reviewer for a number of journals. He is on the executive of the American Association of Sarcoidosis and Other Granulomatous diseases (AASOG).

His contributions to the medical literature include numerous refereed journal articles and a number of book chapters. He is a member of the Canadian Thoracic Society committee responsible for writing the 2017 CTS COPD Position Statement.
